From East: East on US 224 to SR 103 in Willard, OH, turn left (south); after you cross railroad tracks continue on SR 103 about 1.5 miles; SR 103 will turn right, go straight (Baker 47) ahead, to Wagon Wheel on left about 1 mile

From Columbus: I-71 North to Exit 140, north on SR 61, go through Mt. Gilead and into Galion, at the 1st stop light in Galion you will go straight on SR 598, go about 10 miles, cross SR 39, Left at Baker 47 (1st crossroad after you cross SR 39, cross SR98 go 1.5 miles to Wagon Wheel on your right.

From West: US 224 to SR 103in Willard, turn right (south); after you cross railroad tracks continue on SR 103 about 1.5 mils; SR 103 will turn right, go straight ahead (Baker 47), to Wagon Wheel on left about 1 mile.
