CLASSIFICATIONS - NON-REGULAR CLASSES

The following classes will be provided for both Dogs and Bitches:

COMPETITIVE VETERAN – 6 years and under 8 years and 8 years and older. Winners of these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

STUD DOG CLASS – This class is for Stud Dogs and two or more (limit 8) of their get. It is not necessary that the get be under the same ownership as the stud dog. The stud dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with his get. Get must be entered in the regular classes. The class is to be judged only on the merits of the get. Armband numbers of get must be worn in the ring.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as for Stud Dog.

NOHS – All dogs determined to be eligible for NOHS in the BOB Competition class, including WD & WB will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements in BOB competition.

AWARD OF MERIT - At the discretion of the Judge, Awards of Merit may be offered up to a maximum of 10% of the entry in the Best of Breed Class. (As Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Bitch, are the highest awards,) Awards of Merit will not be given to those dogs winning those awards, but to other worthy dogs entered in the Best of Breed Class.

4 TO 6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY CONFORMATION -Thursday & Saturday ONLY – The Four to Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Class is not divined by sex. No Professional handlers unless puppy owned by professional handler.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES - Thursday, Friday, Saturday

Sweepstakes is open to all Great Danes who on the day of the show, will be (6) six months and under (18) eighteen months of age. The entry for sweepstakes shall be made at the same time and on the same entry form as for Regular Classes. Indicate in the space "Additional Classes" your entry for sweepstakes, making sure to indicate the age group you are entering. All dogs entered in sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a Regular Class and at the Regular Class Fee. Dogs entered in Sweepstakes may be shown by anyone in good standing with AKC. ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. - owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE ON A LEASH or confined to their crates except when being judged or in exercise ring.

THERE SHALL BE NO practicing in the show ring

Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practical. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary's office. CANADIAN exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. The Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. A \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee and a Recording Fee of 50Ë will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show. These Event Service and Recording Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the

show, these Fees are to be collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). Fee included in entry fee.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted, which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. It is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, no refund of entry fee will be made. Post Dated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- · The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- · The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurm any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- · Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
